PURPOSE The Partners in Belonging was established in 2018 inspired by Joe Landis, a visionary who dedicated his life's work to serving individuals with special needs. Through his vision, he developed a holistic model of care—the Belonging Model—based on companionship, caring for mind, body and spirit, appreciating the enthusiastic gifts of all people and membership in community. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to a CRHS – North or South senior(s) seeking a 4-year undergraduate degree at an accredited college or university. Preference will be given to students who intend to major in the areas of special education and human services. The scholarship principally targets students that demonstrate leadership, social activism and civic engagement in the area of special education and human services.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE is based on financial need, academic performance, demonstrated leadership, and engagement in social and civic programs including, but not limited to, community service.

Scholarships are awarded annually provided funds are available. Annual award amount up to \$500 (i.e. 2 awards for \$250 or 1 award of \$500 each). The scholarships are a one-year, non-renewable award.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The Council Rock Education Foundation (CREF) awards scholarships on the basis of a comprehensive process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include but are not limited to the following: Academic Accomplishments, Community Service, Social Activism, References, Personal Essay and Financial Need. CREF pays scholarship funds directly to the awardees designated higher education institution of their choice to be applied to the Fall semester of 2019. Scholarships are awarded annually and are not renewable. CREF Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, gender or sexual orientation. Scholarships awarded are based upon the availability of funds and additional qualifying criteria.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must be CRHS-North or South seniors in good standing for with a minimum unweighted GPA
 of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. Applicants must graduate and be accepted as a full-time student at a college or
 university for the upcoming Fall semester
- Applicants should demonstrate special needs involvement with preference given to leadership roles in activities including, but not limited to: - Special Olympics, service groups, volunteer activities and work related.

TIMELINE

- Applications are due March 31 of the applicant's senior year
- Candidates may be asked for an interview by the Scholarship Committee conducted in early April.
- Awardee(s) will receive notification of the award at Senior Awards night in June.

Application Process

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:

- Completed application form.
- Official transcript including senior year grades.
- Two teacher letters of recommendation and guidance counselor letter of recommendation. These can be the same recommendation letters used in the Common Application that were submitted via Naviance.
- A 500-word essay addressing the following areas:
 - Describe how this scholarship will help meet your educational and career goals.
 - Discuss your anticipated areas of study and why you are choosing this direction.
 - Describe your determination and dedication to achieving your social, civic and educational objectives.
- Up-to-date Resume outlining all activities, honors, awards, employment, etc.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Awards will be paid by July 31, 2019 directly to the awardee's institution, provided the following criteria are met after graduation:

- Final year-end transcript showing candidate has graduated high school
- Proof of acceptance to study a 4-year undergraduate degree at an accredited college or university
- Applicant must provide their college student ID and the correct mailing address of their institution's
 Financial Aid Office where the scholarship check is to be remitted
